EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-05

TEMPORARILY CLOSED.

WHEREAS, The Village of Ruidoso must take all necessary precautions to protect employees, families, and the general public. The Village of Ruidoso is working closely with emergency personnel and will continue to reassess the situation as information becomes available.

Now, Therefore, I, Lynn D. Crawford, Mayor of the Village of Ruidoso, New Mexico, do hereby order the public to adhere to the following orders effective on Monday, March 23, 2020 at 12:01 AM.

- A. Those travelers and tourist are discouraged to not travel into the Village of Ruidoso.
- B. Effective immediately, Grindstone Lake and Alto Lake Areas are closed until further notice.
