## How to Prepare for Trial Ruidoso Municipal Court

- 1. It is the defendant's responsibility to make sure that the Court is aware of any address changes from the address on the traffic citation and/or complaint and a telephone number where the court can contact defendant.
- 2. Organize your facts in order and write them down. Practice your story out loud a few times. Stick to the major facts; don't ramble on about tiny details.
- 3. The court will usually not allow hearsay. This means you cannot say that someone said or wrote something unless they are a witness and can verify those statements. No notarized statements are allowed.
- 4. If you plan on using witnesses, subpoenas may be obtained from the Municipal Court Clerk.
- 5. Please provide witness contact information at least 10 days prior to trial date.
- 6. It's the defendant's responsibility to provide any evidence to the Officer/Attorney/Court at least 10 days prior to trial date.
- 7. Failure to appear for your trial could result in a bench warrant for your arrest, up to 90 days in jail and a \$500 fine for contempt of Court.
